MUST HAVE A CURRENT PERMIT

- If your permitted vehicle is not serviceable or you are temporarily driving a different vehicle, you must display a Temporary Permit, available online on the Linfield Public Safety webpage ***
- Linfield Community (Staff/Faculty, students) are not to park in visitor space at any time
- Disabled parking must have a state issued ADA placard
- Parking in 10/15 minutes and overnight parking spaces is strictly enforced
- All Linfield community members parking within the Linfield campus must display a current parking permit, whether you reside on or off campus. Bring this form to Public Safety to receive a replacement permit.
